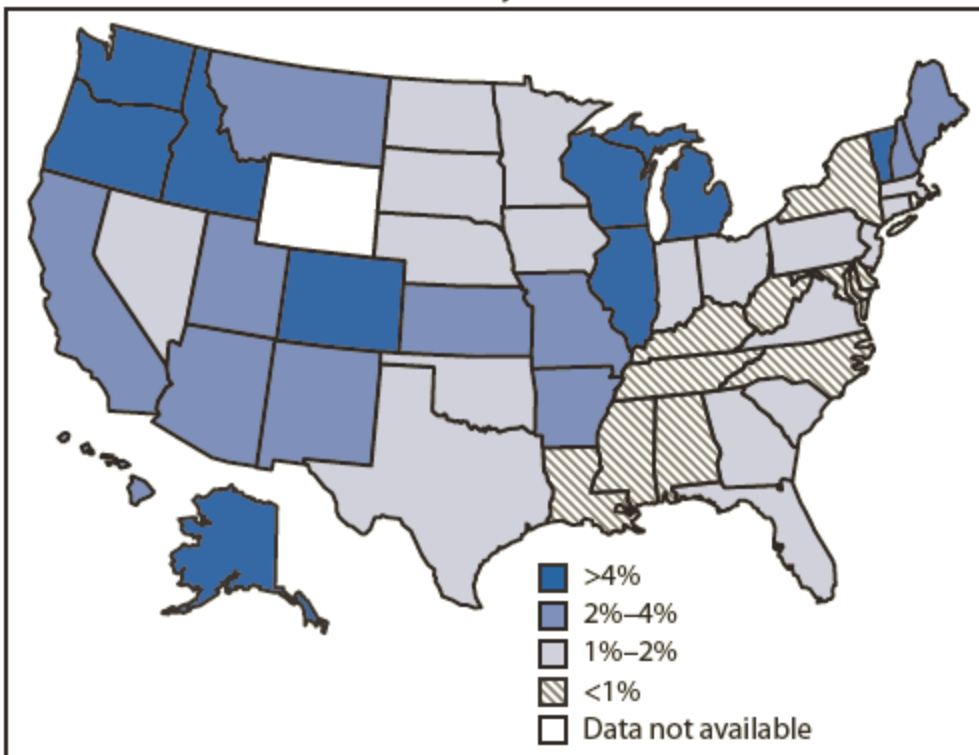


**Estimated percentage of children enrolled in kindergarten who have been exempted from receiving one or more vaccines\* — United States, 2011–12 school year**



\* Exemptions might not reflect a child's vaccination status. Children with an exemption who did not receive any vaccines are indistinguishable from those who have an exemption but are up-to-date for one or more vaccines.

The figure above shows the estimated percentage of children enrolled in kindergarten who were exempt from receiving one or more vaccines in the United States, during the 2011-12 school year. Overall, among the grantees in the 49 states and DC that reported exemptions for the 2011-12 school year, 10 reported <1%, and nine reported >4% total exemption rates.
